

Lloyd's Register Foundation Institute Fellowship

The [Lloyd's Register Foundation Institute for the Public Understanding of Risk](#) (LRFI) at the [National University of Singapore](#) is offering fellowships to professionals from developing countries in Asia to attend an executive education programme "Understanding and communicating risks: Facts, fears and fallacies" in Singapore from 15-18 January 2018. This four-day programme run by LRFI and the [Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy](#) will help participants accurately and intelligently analyse risks in their respective domains; appreciate how people commonly perceive risks; and communicate their risks to stakeholders, citizens/consumers, and the general public.

About the Fellowship

The Institute seeks emerging leaders who are committed to improving risk communication in Asia. The goal is that over time the Fellowship will build a network of leaders committed to improving risk communication in Asia.

The Fellowship is open to professionals from developing countries in Asia working in the area of risk communication, particularly in the fields of health, food and product safety, environmental risks, finance, infocomm technology, and safety and security.

The Fellowship will cover programmes fees, visa and flight costs, as well as accommodation costs incurred by the fellow during the period of the programme. Visa, flight and accommodation costs will be capped at a combined total of S\$2,000 and will be given on a reimbursement basis, following the completion of the course. All interested participants are responsible for obtaining the necessary visas and the Institute will provide a formal letter of invitation for visa applications.

Up to six fellowships will be awarded.

Who is eligible to apply?

Applicants must be:

- Under the age of 45 by January 2018
- Currently employed with at least five years of relevant experience at the time of application
- Proficient in spoken and written English
- Based in Asia and is a citizen of the following countries:

Southeast Asia: Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, Timor-Leste, Vietnam

South Asia: Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Sri Lanka

Northeast Asia: China, Mongolia

Central Asia: Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan

How to apply?

Those wishing to apply will need to send the following documents to dprwyl@nus.edu.sg by 27 October 2017:

- Short curriculum vitae
- A maximum of two A4 pages describing your role in your organisation and your motivation for applying for the programme

What is the selection process?

The Lloyd's Register Foundation Institute Fellows will be selected by the Institute Board based on their accomplishments in the respective fields and the potential impact of their work. It is envisaged that upon completion of the programme, the Fellows would propagate the knowledge acquired and develop impactful risk communication programmes.

Selected fellows will be notified by 17 November 2017.
